There was a Fire Department organized in 1925 known as the Gallupville Fire and Hose Co.. There is no minuate book available for any records. Lester Thornton and Glarence Barber remember a home talent drama being put on to raise funds and some money also was raised by subscription. Lester found in his fahhers diary where on Jan.26,1925, he and Tra Chandler went to Schenectady to see about fire apparatus. Clarence arber discovered the old receipt when the Chemical Tank was purchased Feb. 29,1929, amount \$189.00. Also the old bank book with Chas. Warner, Treas. and the bank failed to record any year date in this. There is a book on hand with the list of apparent members

and a date recorded Jan. 28, 1925.

Three men in the above list of names are present members of our fire depart, ent (1962) Lester Thornton, Adam Manchester and Alvin Manchester.

Apparently after the chemical tank was purchased in 1929 the old company came to a halt. There was a little money on deposit at the Schoharie Bank and it just lay there all through the thirties. Mr. Fain, resident of the bank spoke to someone here in town why they did not do something about this. Talk was started and Clarence Barber former secretary of the old company called a meeting for Jan. 24, 1942.

Here is a minufte record for Jan. 24, 1942

This meeting was called for the purpose of reorganizing the Gallupville Fire and Hose Co. Meeting called to order by Clarence arber former secretary of said company.

Lansing D.Finch was elected chairman and Clarence "arber

Secty. of said meeting.

Motion made and seconded and unanimously carried that we reorganize the Gallupville Fire and Hose Company as a voluntary fire company. Motion made and seconded that we proceed with the election of officers. The following were elected.

William Chase chief

Harold Barber lst assistant

Chester Zimmer 2ns assitsant

Lansing Finch Treasurer Vlarence Parber Secty.

Motion made and seconded and carried that all who wanted to join the company should sigm up at this meeting or before the next meeting. 23 members signed at this meeting and the roll call book shows 34 listed by the next meeting as charter members.

Motion seconded and carried that the next meeting be held on Fri. night, Jan.30,1942 at which time the chief was to secure a speaker on fire apparatus.

Motion made and carried to adjourn.

#### FIRE DEPARTMENT HISTORY

After this reorganization meeting and with our new treasurer in office, the old account at the bank became active in the amount of \$213.60. April 25,1942 the new organization had a roast pork supper with proceeds of \$140.00. Sept.31,1944 a Masguarade dance with proceeds \$160.50.

In 1944 the department joined the Schoharie County Firemen's Association.

With the purchase of the new fire truck by the Fire District with taxpayers money in 1945, the organization of firemen decided they could incorporate and provide the building to house it.

Along about this time the Schoharie Central School District decided to sell the village school in Gallupville. The firemen got busy with plans on buying the property. The taxpayers in the school district were contacted and the feeling was almost unanimous that the fire department should have it. To follow the law it had to be put up at auction and the taxpayers paid off by check from the Central School headquarters.

The sale was February 20,1945. The Fire Dept. bid it in for \$750.00 plus \$20.50 for the stove, secretary desk, Treas. desk and two chairs. The incorporation papers were not complete yet within the law and a gentlemens agreement was the property to be held in our Tresurers name, Lansing Finch, until July 24,1945. At this time the corporation papers were complete and our new name was created, GALLUPVILLE VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPT. INC. The official date was May 7,1945.

It is of intrest how the purchase of this building was handled. At the time of the sale, 7 men, Edward Manchester, Chester Zimmer, Martin Daring, John Solneek, Lester Thornton, Max Wise and Finch Bros. each loaned the fire department \$100.00. This being a temporary loan as the building had to be paid for, check going to the Central School District. They, in due time redistributed the proceeds back to the individual taxpayers in said school district. The taxpayers turned their checks endorsed right over to the fire department. March 30, 57 checks were recorded and the amount \$589.83, with \$47.53 coming in a little later, At the April meeting there were donations by the members of \$210.00 and through the year when the building of the addition was going on donations of \$300.00 are recorded.

As soon as the building was purchased plans went ahead to build the addition for the trucks and a small kitchen on the back of the meeting room.

The grand total cost of this is recorded \$4,071.68.

Money was needed to finance this new building project. The bank was not intrested unless some of the members would back the loan or bet holding in case of failure of our so new organization.

After some discussion and some ideas expressed the plan was formulated to borrow \$3000.00 in ten loans of \$300.00 each with intrest at 4%. Some intrested members made these loans. If anyone needed the money someone else took it over and payments were made yearly. If no one requested the need of their loan the names to be paid off were drawn from a hat.

The pool table was purchased April 9,1946 for \$225.00 This did not come out of the ratreasury. Those intrested in playing went together and bought it.

The jadies Auxiliary was created in April 1949. November 1949 the parade uniforms were aquired by members intrested.

It was April 1953 when the office of president and Vice president was established. The chief presided over the meetings until this time.

At the meeting of November 2, 1953, with the last loan of \$300.00 being paid off the department was free of debt, for the original school building, truck addition and small kitchen.

There being a need for a larger kitchen this project was started at this meeting with a committe to look into it, and present ideas later. At the next annual meeting April 5,1954 it was voted to go ahead with the building program presented, for the present large kitchen on the back. May 25, the trustees were authorized to borrow \$25x20 \$2500. at %4 intrest for this kitchen annex. It was planned to pay this off at not loss than \$300.00 per year/ The loan was made to the fire department by Mark and Lota Zimmer. It was paid off in six years. The last payment being

In 1959 some work was done by the firemen themselves on painting the outside of the building. March 6,1961 a contract was building complete.

July 3,1961, it was voted to lease the G.L.F. land for a ball park and a committee appointed to go ahead with it.

have a central heating system installed for the complete building the bid of Ottman and Enders was accepted for \$1500.00. This was completed in January 1963.
