Policy Name: **6.0 Medical Leave**

It is the Fire District's policy that any illness (including childbirth), surgical procedure, injury, or any assistive or immobilization device that restricts a member's normal functioning ability shall immediately remove that member from active status and they may not involve themselves with any physical activity related to the Fire Department or Fire District. Members may still attend training, meetings and drills as they are able, but shall not actively participate in any physical activity.

Members who receive professional medical attention for their injury/condition must have a doctor's note giving permission to return to active status

Members who are incapacitated for more than fourteen (14) consecutive days will require a "Medical Clearance Form" (below) to be signed and dated by their physician, the Chief, and the member prior to returning to duty.

_____ may return to full-time duty with the Gallupville Volunteer Fire Department, without any medical restrictions. Said restrictions may include, lifting, climbing, stretching, carrying weight, exertion, and walking on uneven footing.
